Samsung Galaxy Watch Controls & settings guide

Pairing your phone with your child's Samsung Galaxy Watch allows you to manage the device using controls available through Google Family Link.

1 Setting up a new watch

Before setting up a new watch, you must download the Galaxy Wearable app and pair the watch to your phone.

To set up a new watch:

Step 1 – Select **Set up for a child** and proceed with the software update.

Step 2 – After the software update, pair the watch to your phone by clicking **Connect**.

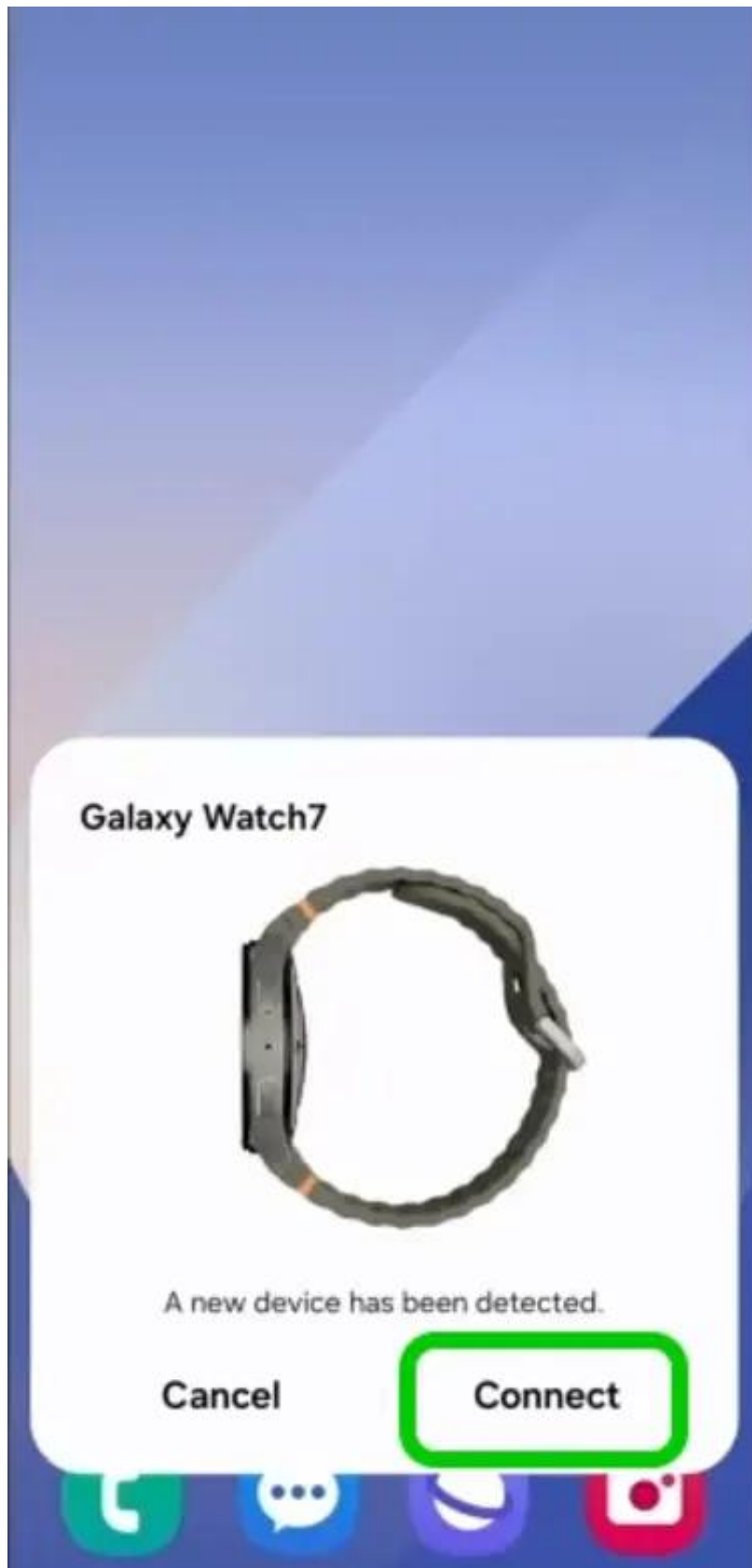

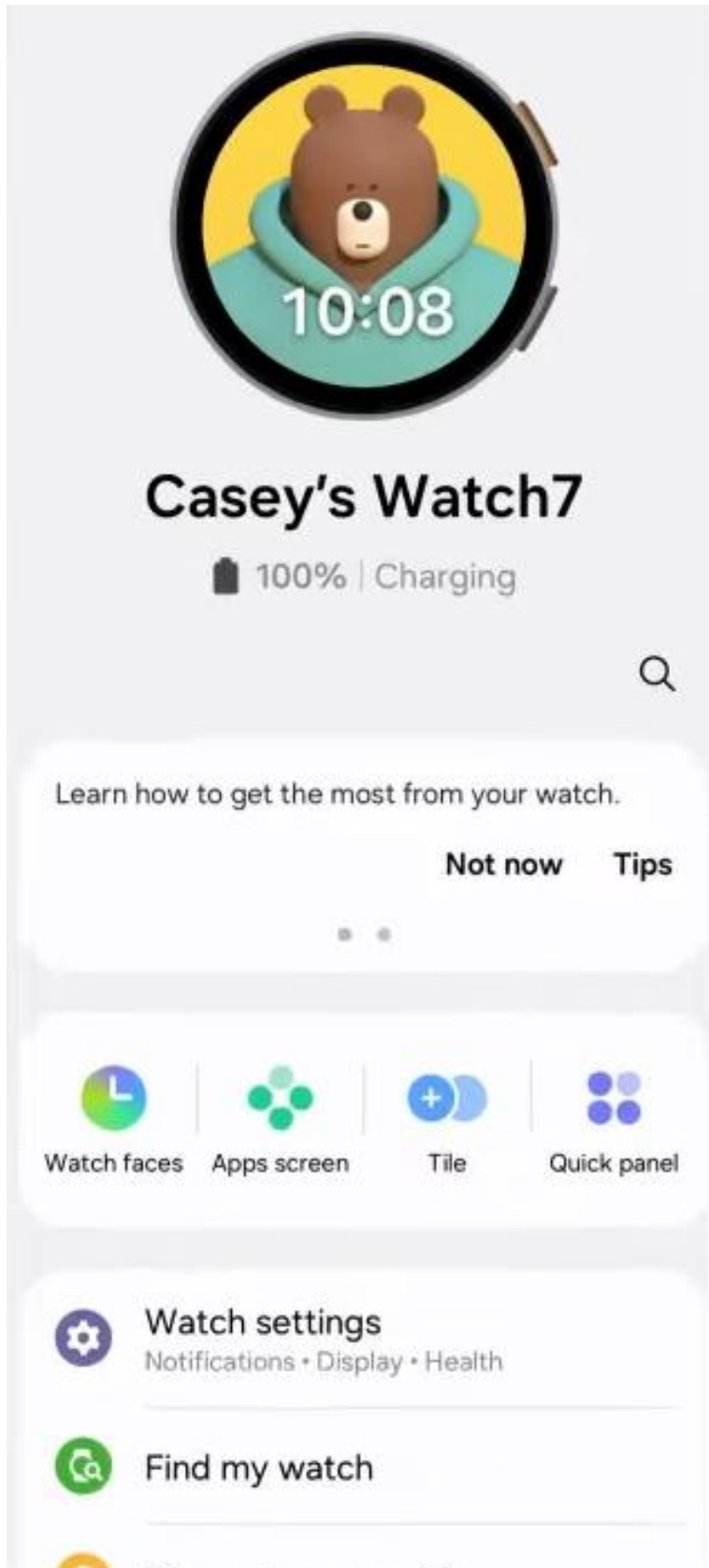

2 Setting up an existing watch

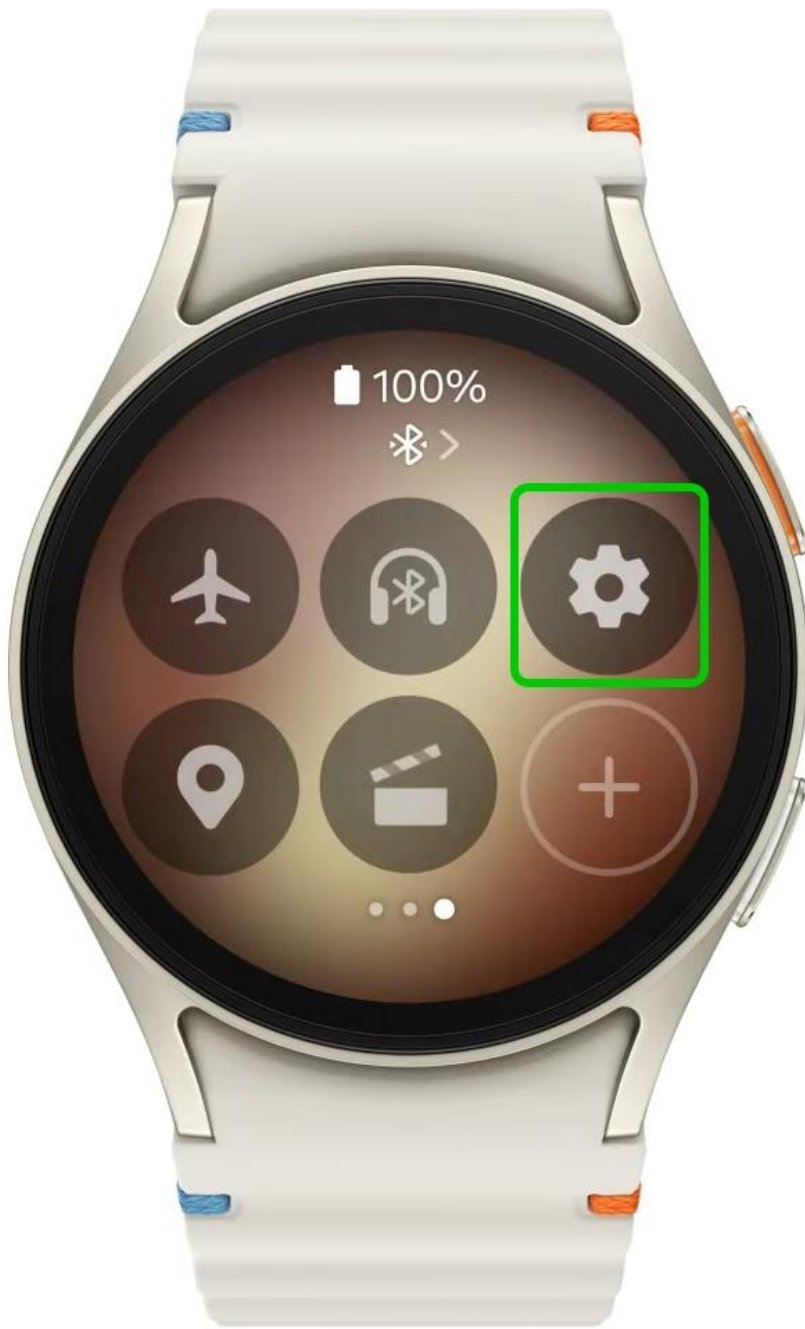
You can set up Galaxy Watch for Kids on an existing watch using the watch settings.

To set up on an existing watch:

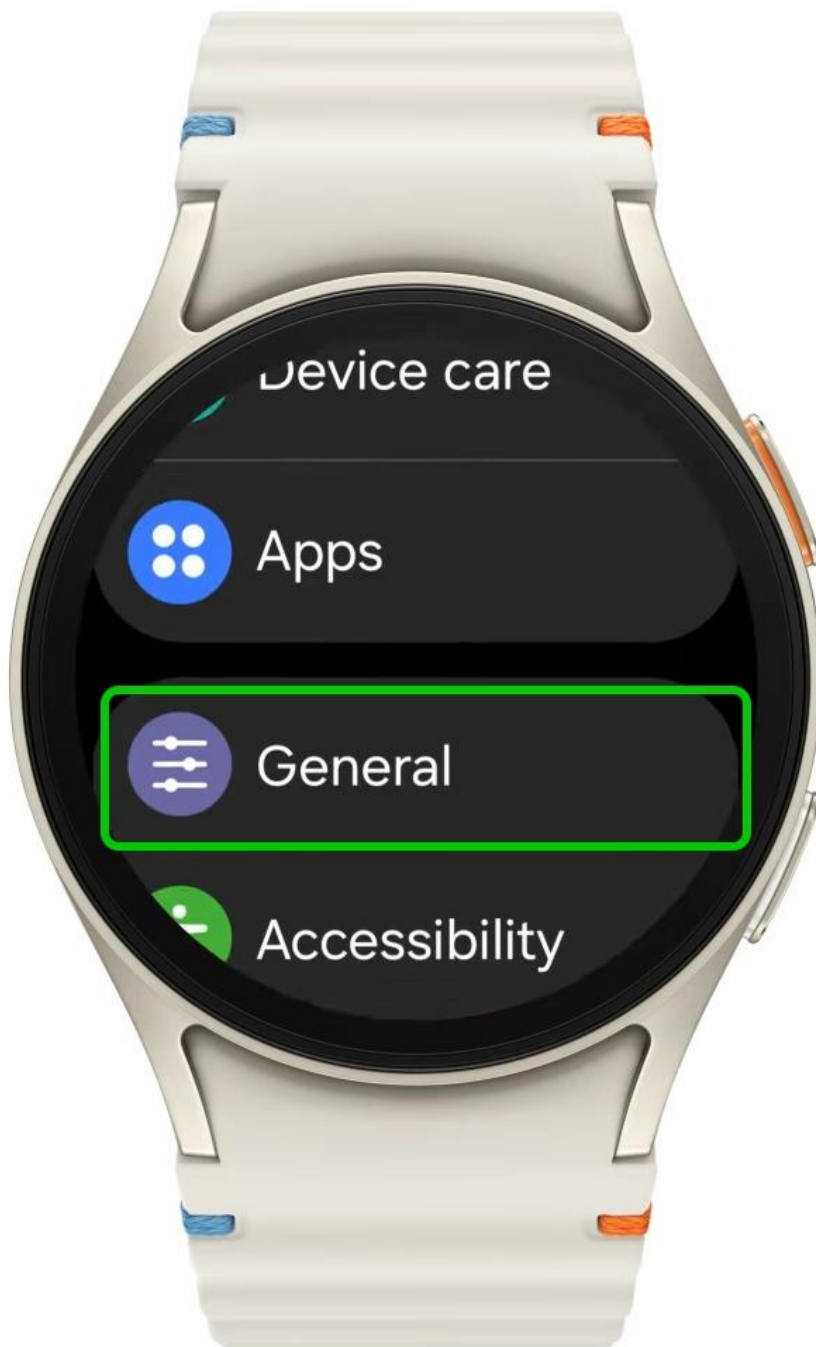
Step 1 – Pull down the quick panel and tap **Settings**.

Step 2 – Scroll down and select **General**.
