



Windows 7 Safety Controls & settings guide

The Windows 7 Parental controls is a valuable tool for restricting the content a child can have access to on the computer. You can restrict time, games, and programs.







To set parental controls on windows 7:

Step 1 – From the desktop, click Windows menu and click on control panel.



Step 2 – From the desktop, click windows menu and click on control panel.





Step 3 – Select '**User Accounts and Family Safety**' to create a new account for your child.

You will need to add a password to the account.

Step 4 – Then go back to '**User Accounts and Family Safety'** and select 'Parental Controls'.



Step 5 – Turn parental controls 'on.





Step 6 - Select the 'Time Limits' options and select the squares to turn them blue.

Step 7 - Then select 'Games' to restrict which games can be played.



Step 8 - Choose 'Set game ratings'.



Step 9 - Scroll down and select different types of content you want to block.



Step 10 - Next, select the 'Allow and block specific programs ' option.
