
How to use the Quick Panel to access Samsung Kids

Step 1. Double-tap or select the bar from the top and drag it downwards.

Step 2. Drag down to open [Quick panel].

Step 3. Next, navigate to the next page on the [Quick panel] and tap [Samsung Kids].

Step 4. Tap the [Start] button on the [Samsung Kids] screen. Samsung Kids is now ready to use.



How to set up Samsung Kids

Step 1. Open [Samsung Kids].

Step 2. Create and confirm a 4-digit PIN and confirm to toggle Parental control mode or exit the app. (Do not share your pin with your child.)



Download a native app

Step 1. Your download will start when you touch a native app icon.

Step 2. Installation is complete when the app has been downloaded.

Your child can now get started.

Launch Parental control mode

Step 1. Tap the [Settings] menu in the top-right hand corner of the [Samsung Kids] screen.

Step 2. Tap [Parental control] from the menu.


Step 3. Enter your PIN to unlock the [Parental control mode].

Now you can start using Parental Control.

Add a child's profile


Step 1. Tap the [Enter] button.


Step 2. Enter your child's name and date of birth and tap [Save].

Registration is now complete.

Set daily playtime

Step 1. Double-tap or select the bar from the top and drag it downwards.

Step 2. Drag down to open the [Quick panel].

Step 3. Navigate to the next page on the [Quick panel] and tap the text [Samsung Kids].

Step 4. Select a daily playtime limit from the list of default time options, and then tap the [Finish] button when you are done.














Setting daily playtime limits

Step 1. Tap the [Settings] menu in the top right corner of the [Samsung Kids] screen.

Step 2. Select [Parental control] from the menu.

Step 3. Enter your PIN to unlock the Parental control mode.

Step 4. Tap [More] in the set daily playtime section of the [Parental control] page.

Step 5. Drag the bar left and right to set a daily playtime limit.



How to add a contact

Step 1. Tap [Contacts] at the bottom of the Parental control page.

Step 2. Tap [Add] button.

Step 3. Select the contact you want to add from the list and tap [Add] to confirm your selection.

Your child will now be able to place voice calls to the contact you have added using Samsung Kids.





How to allow app access


Step 1. Tap [Apps] at the bottom of the Parental control page.

Step 2. Tap the [Add] button.

Step 3. Select the app you want to add from the list.


Step 4. Tap [Add] to confirm your selection.


The app is now accessible via Samsung Kids.













How to allow access to a media file

Step 1. Tap [Media] at the bottom of the Parental control page.


Step2. Tap the [Add] button.

Step 3. Select the album or file you want to add and press the [Add] button to confirm your selection.

How to add an audio file

Step 1. Tap [Music] at the bottom of the Parental control page.

Step 2. Tap the [Add] button.

Step 3. Select the audio file you want to allow access to and tap the [Add] button to confirm.

How to close the Samsung Kids app

Step 1. Tap [Settings] in the top right-hand corner of the Samsung Kids screen.

Step 2. Tap [Close Samsung Kids] from the menu.

Step 3. Enter your PIN to quit out of the app.
