




How many children game online?







of parents agree gaming is a way to spend quality time together as a family (39% for mums and 49% for dads)




of parents agree they share their own games with their children (41% for mums and 46% for dads)



of parents agree they never play with child across any device **(46% for mums and 38% for dads)**


What are parents concerned about gaming online?




What are parents views on the benefits of gaming?


