You can enable restrictions to stop your children from usng specific features and applications on an iPhone, including blocking access to iTunes, resttrict explict content and in-app purchasing. You can also limit access to the camera and sharing of photos.

Open the settings application on the iPhone and tap the "General" section.





Scroll down and tap on "Restrictions".

Tap on "Enable Restrictions".



Enter a 4 digit passcode that you will use to toggle on and off the restrictions.

Scroll down on the "Restrictions" page to see a full list of the features you can set restrictions on. You can turn off functions such as the Camera, Facetime, set age restrictions on content that can be viewed or apps installed plus turn off the ability to access photos for already installed apps.
