How to guide

1. Turn on or off private mode

While in a party with friends or when teamed up with random players during a match, a text chat channel becomes available. This setting controls whether or not this account can hear receive or send messages in the text chat channel

Get to the menu by tapping the cog in the top-right hand corner. Tap 'Party Privacy' then choose either Public, Friends only or Private.

2. Report player

Get to the menu by tapping the cog in the top-right hand corner then tap 'Report Player'. Enter the details by clicking on the tabs, and choose the appropriate action then follow the online instructions.

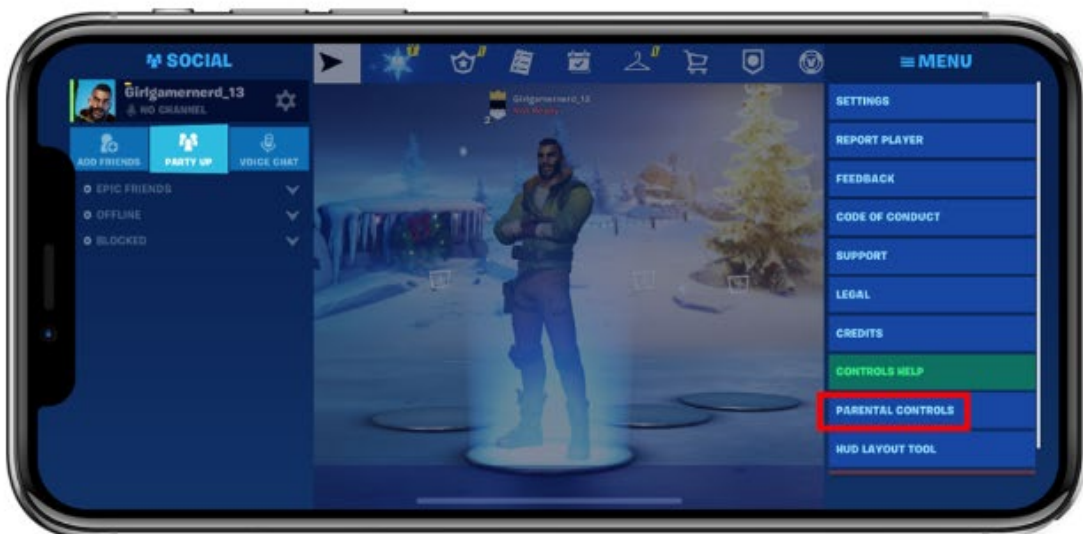
3. Set parental controls

Get to the menu by tapping the cog in the top-right hand corner then tap 'Parental Controls' then tap 'Set up parental controls'.

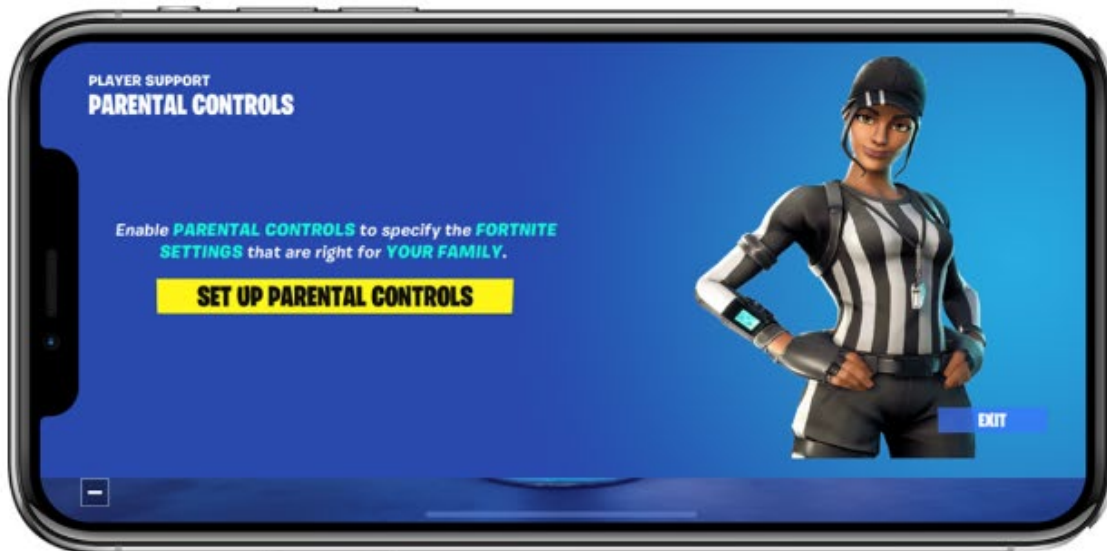

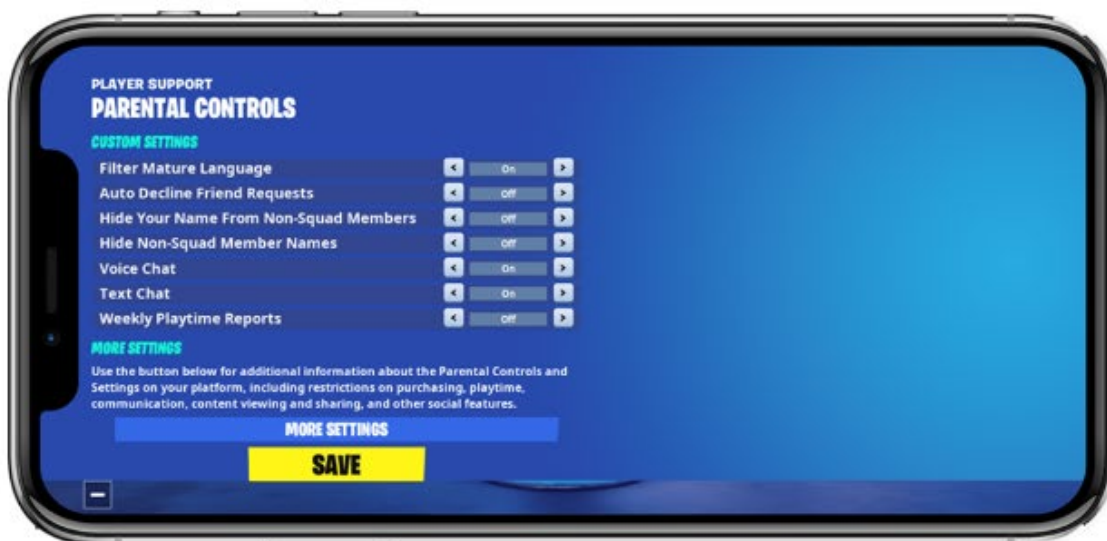

4. Select from the list of controls you want to turn on or off, such as 'Filter Mature Language' then tap 'Save'.



5. Enter a 6-digit parental control PIN, which will be required whenever adjusting any parental control setting. Tap 'Next'.
