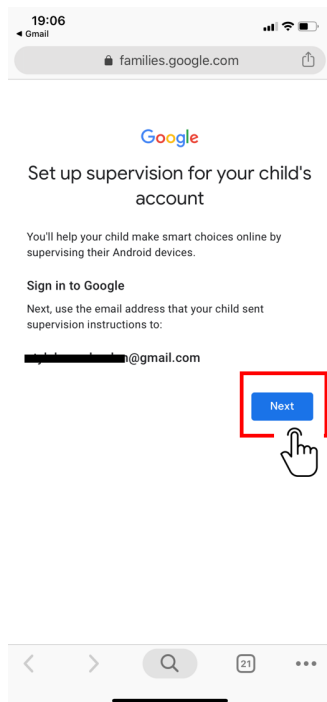


Become a Family Manager First, sit down with your child as later they will need to allow supervision. Download the Family Link App to create an account for your child or you can add supervision to your child's existing Google Account. Follow the prompts to set up supervision permission from their Android device. This should take about 10 minutes.

Set up supervision from your Google account Once your child has given you permission, you should receive an email confirmation. Click the link and tap 'Next'.



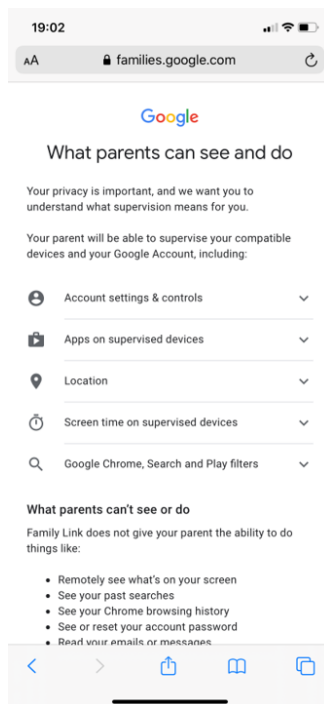

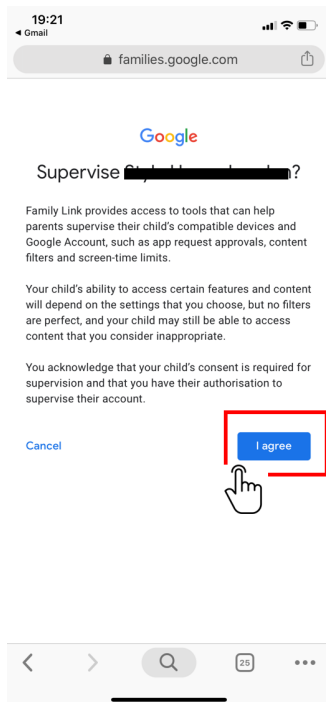
If you are not a family member you will see the next screen. Tap 'I'm ready'. If you are already a family member, proceed to step 5.

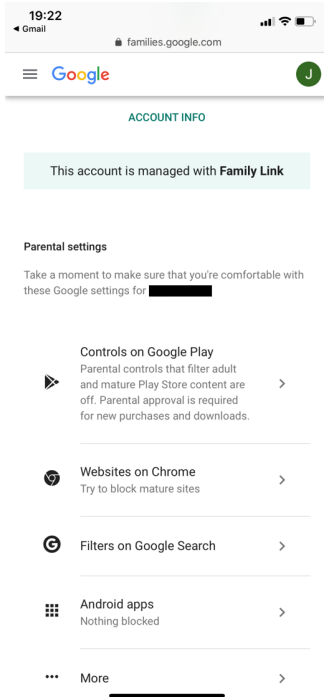
Tap 'I agree' to supervise your child's account and then tap 'Next'.

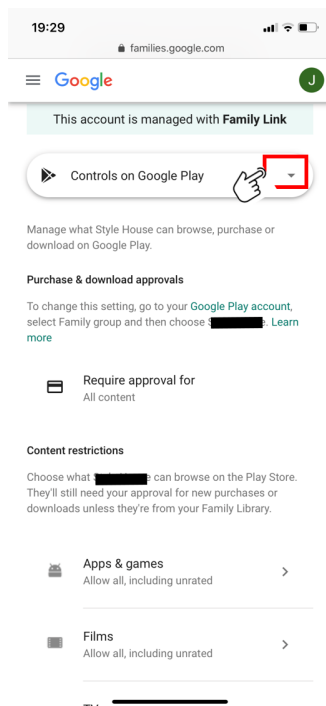
Set parental settings Your account is now managed with Family Link. Take a moment to make sure you're comfortable with the settings for your child.
