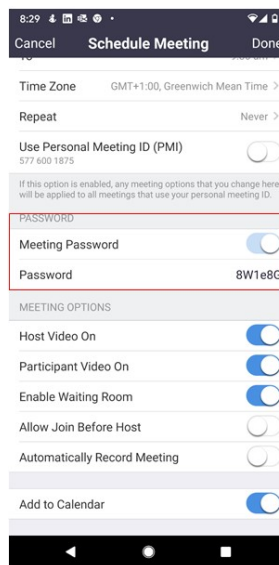

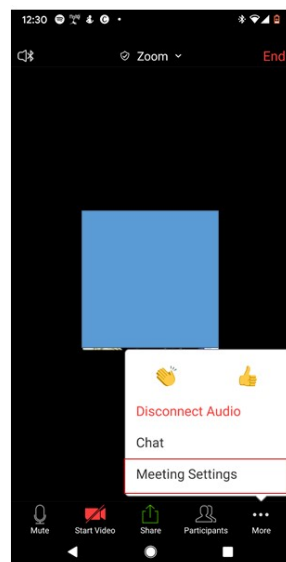

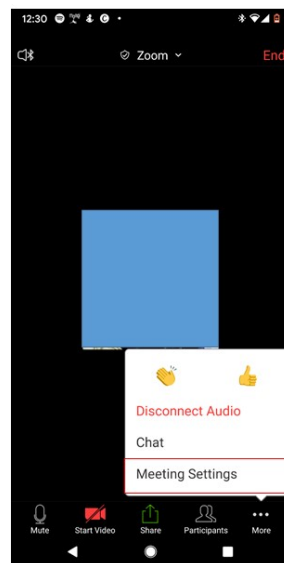
- Lock down your meeting Once you have started your meeting do the following: - Tap 'More' - Go to 'Meeting settings' - Under 'Security' tap 'Lock Meeting ' as soon as all participants have arrived

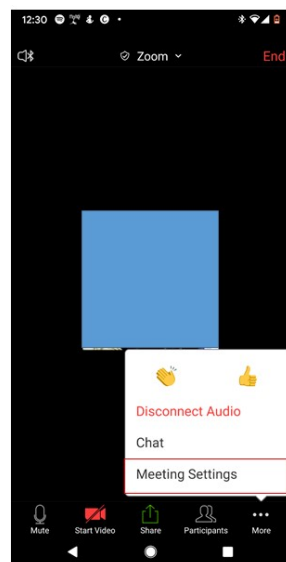


Turn off participant screen sharing – Tap ‘More’ – Go to ‘Meeting settings’ – Under ‘Allow Participants to’ Disable ‘Share screen’

- Use Waiting Rooms This will allow you to screen people before they enter the meeting. Once you have started your meeting do the following: - Tap 'More' - Go to 'Meeting settings' - Under 'Security' enable 'Waiting Room'

Disable 'Join before host' option Do not allow people to join the meeting before you. - Tap on the Schedule icon. - Under 'Meeting option' disable 'Allow join before host'
